

Woman jailed for offering bribe

A Chinese national was sentenced to three weeks' jail yesterday for attempting to bribe a Singapore Customs Officer. On May 31, Zhu Xiaolu, 30, arrived at Changi Airport with commercial goods worth US\$10,210 (S\$14,000) without a permit. She then offered Higher Customs Officer Siow Teck Meng US\$200 as a bribe for him to release the goods.

The officer rejected it and reported the matter to the Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau.
